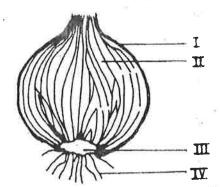

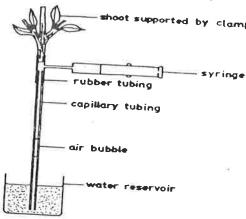
The diagram below is an illustration of the longitudinal section of a plant organ. Study it and answer questions 6 to 8.

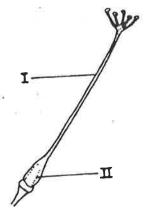

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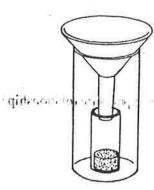

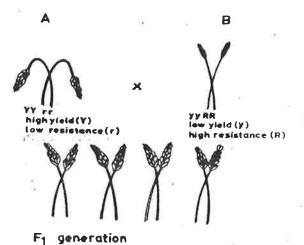
